Emergency Preparedness

A medical emergency list is maintained by the Village as part of the Village's emergency preparedness plan. This is a list of residents who use medical equipment that may be compromised in an emergency or power outage. This would include heart assist devices (V.A.D.), oxygen equipment, or any other equipment with limited or no battery backup.

Please help us keep this list current so that in the event of an emergency priority can be given to those most in need. IF you or a family member needs to be placed on our list, please contact the village office with name, address, condition or equipment details, and emergency contact information. This information will be kept confidential to necessary personnel only.

Brush Pick up



Our summer brush and leaves pick-up is on **the 2nd and 4th Monday** of each month. If Monday is a holiday, then pick-up will be on Tuesday.

Place the brush loosely piled, putting small tangled brush in a separate pile so we can pick it up with a loader and transport it. Place large logs in a separate pile in 6 ft. lengths. (Please remember we are a brush pick-up service not a tree removal service)

All bagged debris (leaves, grass clippings, etc.) MUST be placed in a paper bag. We will no longer pick up debris in plastic bags for biodegradable reasons.
