Cold Weather and your Electric Bill

In January, New York State set a record for electricity usage on Jan. 7 during the vortex-induced cold snap, breaking the previous peak winter demand record set in December 2004.

Arctic temperatures blanketing the state for the past few weeks have led to record power usage and increased energy costs. Please be prepared for higher usage and increased electric costs.

The next electric bill will be mailed on 2/21 and is for the month of January usage, please plan ahead and be prepared.

Comprehensive Planning Committee
