Recycling Standards:

- Aluminum, tin, bimetal food and beverage containers
- Green, brown, and clear unbroken glass from food and beverage containers
- Empty Aerosol cans
- #1-#7 Plastic only, Milk, juice, water, cider jugs, Laundry detergent and shampoo bottles
- Milk and juice cartons and drink boxes
- Newspapers, brown paper bags, magazines, catalogs, inserts/writing/computer/copier paper, spiral notebooks
- Corrugated boxes, pizza boxes, cereal/snack/pasta/cracker/tissue/gift/shoe boxes, etc.
- Junk mail including window envelopes, greeting cards, etc. To prevent identity theft tear or shred your bills, financial statements, and junk mail before recycling. Place shredded paper in clear plastic bags.
- Phone books, paperbacks, hardcover books

Do not Recycle:

- No paint cans, pots and pans, scrap metal, coat hangers, drinking glass, pyrex, light bulbs, ceramics, window or mirror glass, clay flower pots, crystal, ovenware. No plastic bags, automotive oil or gas containers, Styrofoam, six pack holders. No wet or soiled papers, tissue paper, no paper toweling, soiled boxes or wax board. No wet or soiled books or directories.
