Mayor's Message

The weather is opportune to enjoy some, or all, of them.

The 4th Annual Disc Golf Tournament took place on the 20th; all participants enjoyed 2 rounds of 18 holes of golf. Much appreciation goes out to Tim and Sarah Campbell for running the tournament this year; they did a great job.

Summer work is in full swing in the village; some of the work includes a new metal roof on the front pavilion in Hickory Park. Plots in the community garden are growing, the Carpenter fountain is cleaned and running, annual maintenance of village winter equipment is complete, and the apron at the entrance to Sage Pavilion has been installed. Thank you to the staff for lawn mowing, tree trimming, etc that is continually being done.

There has been a large amount of brush picked up in the village due to usual spring clean up. There will be a gate installed at the entrance to the WWTP to prevent illegal dumping of brush and construction waste. We pay for chipping of those materials every other year at a cost of between \$8000 to \$8500. An agreement has been made with Waste Management to take the brush and chip for the landfill.

A new scanner has been installed for collecting data from electric meters for billing, septic tanks are being pumped, electric and sewer work are being done for the two new business buildings being constructed in the industrial park. Behind the scenes architectural work and paperwork are being done as work on buildings participating in the Main Street grant program gets closer.

Enjoy the village walking trail, play a game of disc golf, exercise in Hickory Park, picnic at the pavilions....enjoy summer in the village!!


