Old Business

Sign Law

Planning Board Chairperson, René Vurraro, was on hand to discuss changes to the Sign Law to clarify a section that may be confusing. She also explained the concept of “Form Based Zoning” that she learned at a recent training and suggested that the Board consider redoing the Zoning Law in that format. René suggested the Board use a consultant to guide the process.

The Board agreed to make the change to the Sign Law that Ms. Vurraro proposed.
